

SMOKING ON SCHOOL PREMISES

Due to the health hazards associated with smoking, and in accordance with federal and state law, the Board of Education prohibits smoking or other tobacco use in all school buildings, on school property, or at school-sponsored activities, except as permitted under policy 9330, Smoking by School Personnel.

The district's smoking policy shall be prominently posted in each building. The Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee is responsible for informing individuals smoking in a non-smoking area that they are in violation of Article 13 of the Public Health Law and/or federal Pro-Children Act of 1994.
